*Therefore, in June 2013, the BCS-Leaders of the TED and EUD voted to develop a mobile-App.

between real people.








*The solution is an

integrated online System






*The following slides are **NOt** showcasing the actual design of the App.

It is just a rough demonstration of how it could be working.





- * The first time a user opens the App, she will be asked to log in with her account or create a new account.
- * It is also possible to take a look at sample-lessons without an account.





- * Once the user is logged in, she gets to the Homescreen.
- * For all returning users, this will be the first screen they see.





* All available courses are displayed on this screen, with a short description.







- * The course-screen offers a detailed description of the course.
- * If the user scrolls down, she will have three options:









- * The Lesson Preview is for users who are trying the App without an account.
- * Users who are logged in can start the first lesson right away, or download it for offline use.







- * This is a sample lesson. The content can contain text, pictures, tables or videos.
- * It can spread over several screens.

















* Once the user is finished reading and answering the questions, she can submit her answers.







- * In the course overview, the user can see her progress and which topics are still ahead of her.
- * Once the advisor has reviewed her answers, the next lesson will automaticall be activated (purple).







* The "My Courses"-screen displays all courses which are active as well as those which the user has already completed.







* Once the advisor has reviewed the answers, the user will get a message informing her that a new lesson is now available.







- * In addition, the messaging function can be used for personal correspondence between the advisor and the participant.
- * This way questions which are more complex, or do not pertain to the active course can be answered.







* If the user allows for it, the App will also send him push-notifications, once a new lesson is available.











*Through this App,

130.000.000 people

would have access to the Gospel

everywhere they go.
